The following itineraries are for typical British Wildlife Centre Mammal Photography Days and Owl Photography Days. They are guidelines only and timings are approximate. The content of the mammal days is very similar for photography afternoon/evenings which run from 2.15pm to 8pm, and the itinerary shown is simply moved to later in the day. *Itineraries may change due to weather conditions and the availability of animals.*
