Winter Days are excellent value and offer the photographer the advantages of even light conditions and the luxurious winter coats of the animals.



The days are led by a member of our experienced keeper team and include:- **red squirrels - foxes - Scottish wildcats - otters - harvest mice - polecats - stoats - weasels - mink**

- Photography Days are for amateurs only and the group size is a maximum of 10.
- Arrival 9.30am, photography 10am to 3.30pm with an hour for lunch/free time.
- Advance booking is essential. Payment is made at the time of booking and is non-refundable. Should you be unable to attend we may be able to transfer your booking to an alternative date.
- You are advised to bring a packed lunch with you as our Coffee Shop will be closed. Complimentary tea/coffee is provided and you may purchase snacks and cakes.
- Winter Photography Days take place in most weather conditions. Should the Centre consider conditions unsuitable or unsafe you will be re-booked on another date.
- Our Photography Days are packed with photo opportunities so it's advisable to bring a fully charged camera battery and plenty of memory. You'll need it!
